













WANT TO BECOME A TEACHER? APPLY TO THE FUTURE LEADERS PROGRAMME

The Future Leaders Programme (FLP) is a teacher development programme that provides school-based mentoring, work-integrated learning and professional development to pre-service teachers while they study towards a B.Ed. degree through a distance learning institution.

The programme is run by the Global Teachers Institute (GTI), a non-profit organisation whose mission is to shift the way children are taught by transforming teacher education both in South Africa and globally.

The programme is now recruiting aspiring teachers throughout South Africa who wish to pursue a B.Ed. degree in ECD/Foundation or Foundation/Intermediate phases to enrol into the programme as intern teachers starting on 7 January 2020. **Deadline for application is 11 October 2019.**

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Each intern accepted into the programme will be placed in a participating host school, be paired with an experienced mentor and receive ongoing professional development and support for the duration of their B.Ed. degree.

Intern teachers will receive:

- A full bursary covering:
 - Tuition fees not covered by NSFAS
 - Books and Equipment
 - SACE Registration Fees
 - Living and Transport Allowance from R 2400 per month
- Individual mentoring
- Weekly training and professional development
- · Classroom team teaching
- Academic support
- Domestic and international travel opportunities
